



## **COMPASS ACADEMY 9<sup>th</sup> GRADE APPLICATION 2018-2019**

**Please read the following information carefully so you fully understand the application process for Compass Academy.**

Compass Academy will have 150 slots for incoming freshmen. Of those, 25 slots will be set aside for a lottery for the siblings of current Compass students who will still be at Compass for the 2018-2019 school year. Another 25 slots will be set aside to ensure the school's demographics are representative of the district. Those slots will be filled by students who meet certain criteria such as socio-economic status, ethnicity, need for special programs, etc.

The remaining 100 slots will be filled by a general lottery, which will be held the first week in March. All students who have submitted an application and meet the eligibility requirements will be entered into the general lottery. Those who have earned additional chances by participating in various events and activities will be entered into the lottery multiple times, which will increase their chances of acceptance. *(Please see the Overview of the Compass Academy Application Process on the district website for important dates and a complete list of these activities.)*

Idaho Falls School District 91's magnet high school, Compass Academy, provides students with a completely different experience than the one they would receive in the district's comprehensive high schools. Please take a moment to review some of the features that make this school unique.

- ⇒ Students must apply to attend Compass Academy. There are no GPA or academic requirements. **Applications will be accepted 7:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. from Feb. 20-23 at the district office, 690 John Adams Parkway.**
- ⇒ Compass Academy uses project-based learning, which allows students to learn key concepts by solving problems and applying what they have learned to the real world.
- ⇒ Students will learn collaboratively, doing most work in groups.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students will work in a 1:1 Technology environment. They will receive a laptop and use that device to do research, participate in projects and submit homework. Students will be responsible for that device, including any damage or loss that may occur.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students will take core subjects such as English, math, science and social studies, as well as electives. However, the school does not offer the full array of electives offered at the comprehensive high schools. Courses may also have different durations than other schools.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students must meet the same graduation requirements as students in the comprehensive high schools.
- ⇒ Students can only transfer in or out of Compass to one of the district's comprehensive high schools during the summer or at the end of the first trimester. Because Compass students take classes in a different sequence than at the comprehensive high schools, students who transfer may need to retake some classes or take different classes in order to meet the district's graduation requirements.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students will be graded on content knowledge, as well as other critical career skills like agency, collaboration and written and oral communication skills.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students will present their content knowledge and skills to community members on a regular basis. They may also be required to do internships, community service and present outside of normal school hours.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students will be expected to abide by the school's unique culture of trust, respect and responsibility.
- ⇒ Compass Academy students can take part in sports and extracurricular activities at the school they are zoned to attend.
